

SCHEDULE FOR DALLAS TRIP
October 10-11, 1958

Thursday

- 7:00 p.m. Polish instruments.
- 8:30 p.m. Load equipment. Tubas (polished) and percussion equipment in cases. Place all props on truck. Tuba and percussion players will assist prop boys.

Friday

- 12:45 p.m. Assemble on tennis courts in pre-game formation, with shakos in shako boxes. Do not take seats on buses until roll has been checked and meal allowances have been issued. Each band member will be permitted to take one small suitcase.
- 1:00 p.m. Buses leave Norman.
- 5:30 p.m. Arrive at Dallas. All buses to YMCA.

Boys will report to gymnasium located on 3rd floor of YMCA. Will enter YMCA in following order: seniors and graduate students, juniors, sophomores and freshmen. May use rest rooms and shower rooms on first three floors of YMCA--not permitted to go above third floor.

Girls will report to Baptist Church Recreational Center located one block from YMCA. Will enter in following order: seniors and graduate students, juniors, sophomores and freshmen.

We are greatly indebted to the First Baptist Church and the YMCA for overnight housing in Dallas. We must abide by their regulations. Please be considerate of the permanent residents of the YMCA. Use good judgment--avoid excessive noise. Drinking or possession of alcoholic beverages is absolutely forbidden.

Towels and soap will be furnished. Every bandsman should bring one or two clothes hangers. The band will be billed for all towels lost or stolen.

Boys of the band will not be permitted to enter the Baptist Church Recreational Center at any time.

- 12:30 a.m. Curfew. All band members will be expected to abide by this curfew.
- 1:00 a.m. Lights out!

Saturday

- 6:45 a.m. Reveille.
- 7:30 a.m. Breakfast. Band members (in uniform) will go through the YMCA cafeteria lines in the following order: seniors and graduate students, juniors, sophomores and freshmen.
- 8:45 a.m. Board buses. Roll check. Depart for Cotton Bowl.
- 9:45 a.m. Assemble in rank formation on parking lot located south of the Cotton Bowl. In pre-game roster.
- 10:00 a.m. Rehearsal in Cotton Bowl. Radio and TV engineers and camera men will be checking our band throughout the entire rehearsal. Be alert at all times. Return to buses immediately following rehearsal.

Saturday - continued

- 12:00 noon Lunch will be served at bus area.
1:00 p.m. Assemble at buses. Pick up plumes.
1:15 p.m. Line up rank formation (pre-game roster). Be certain that you have both the red and black march folios. The black half-time folios will be picked up at the conclusion of the half-time performance.
1:30 p.m. Band will enter Cotton Bowl.

Band will leave for downtown Dallas one hour after game.

- 7:00 p.m. Bus #1 leaves for Norman.
9:00 p.m. Bus #2 leaves for Norman.
11:00 p.m. Bus #3 leaves for Norman.
1:00 a.m. Buses #4 and #5 leave for Norman.

Each member of the band should be mindful of the need to be careful about personal appearance throughout the trip.

Girls are requested to wear dresses or skirts and blouses (no shorts or slacks, PLEASE!). Boys are requested to wear suits or slacks and sport coats.

The band uniform must be well-policed whenever worn in public - buttons buttoned, cross straps and all accessories worn correctly.

We are conspicuous individuals whenever we appear in public in our band uniforms. Let us make certain that our conduct reflects creditably upon ourselves, our band and our school.
